# Basic Concept

## KreaTerm

An Internet communications program that enables a computer to function as a terminal working from a remote computer.

You need to install this program in all the computers that you want to use as terminals of your server.

# Installation

## Installing The KreaTerm

Place the **KreaTerm** CD in your drive and wait for the setup program to start. Or you can download the program from the Kreateck web page.



After the welcome screen, select **Next** to start the setup or **Cancel** to exit.

From the list of options select Install Kreateck e-Terminal and click **Next**.

From the KreaTerm Folder double click on the KreaTerm icon to start the application.



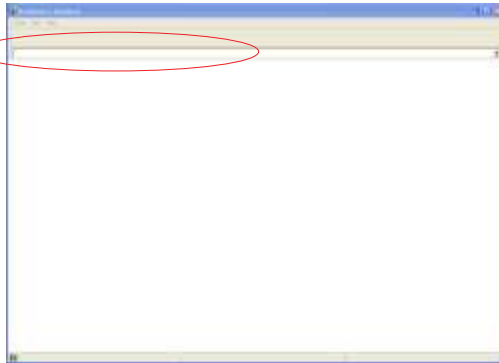

# How to use the Program

## Running From The Command Line

Once you have the program on the screen, type in the command line the instructions to connect to your server.

Command line



The instruction you type in must have the following format:

**“server address:port number/workspace/application name”**

Sample: This command line will run the Administrator Enterprise from your server in your computer.

**192.168.0.1/demo/admadv**

When you don't specify a port in your command line, the KreaTerm use the 1365 which is the default KreaServer port, if you run the server in another port as the 1360 for example you must use the following command:

**192.168.0.1:1360/demo/admadv**

### Setting The Auto Start

If you are planning to always access the same application from your server, you can set the KreaTerm to connect automatically every time you click in its Icon.

To setup the auto start select Edit->Autostart from your menu, then enter the information for you're the application and press Ok.

The information needed to setup the auto start is:

- The Server address.
- The Server Workspace name.
- The Application Name.
- The Application Password.
- The Server Port Number.



Once you finish setting the information press Ok. Next time you hit in the KreaTerm Icon the terminal will automatically connect and download your application.
